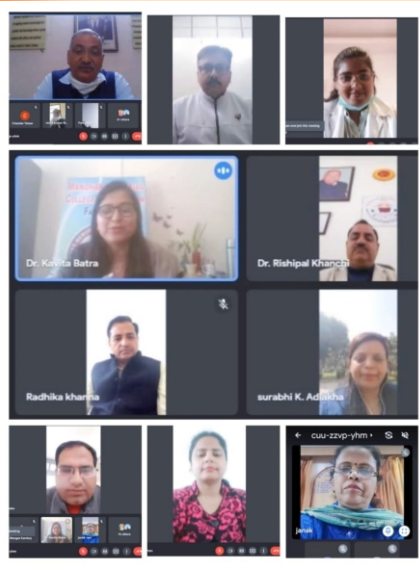

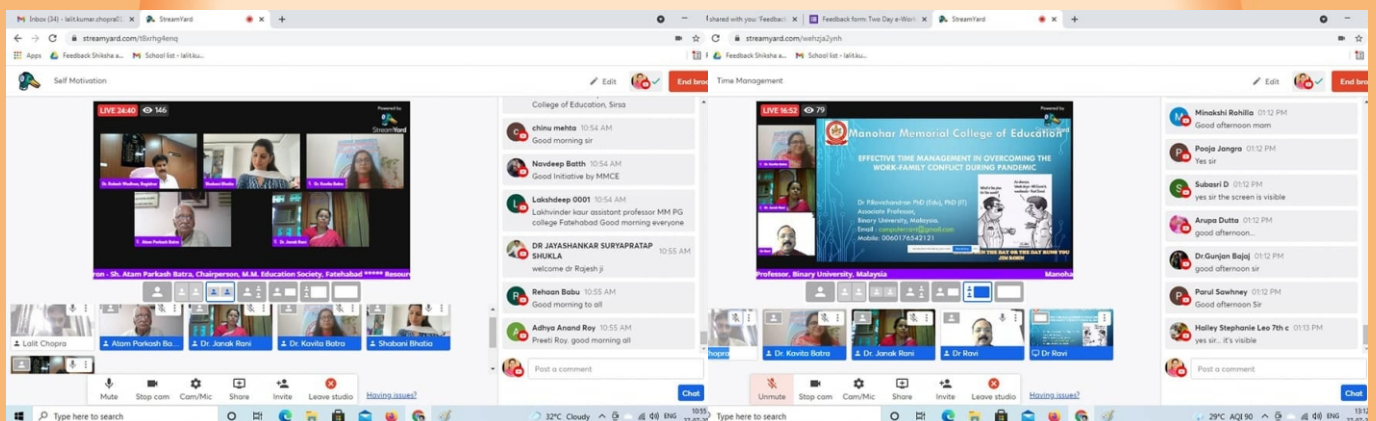
## Lohri Celebrations

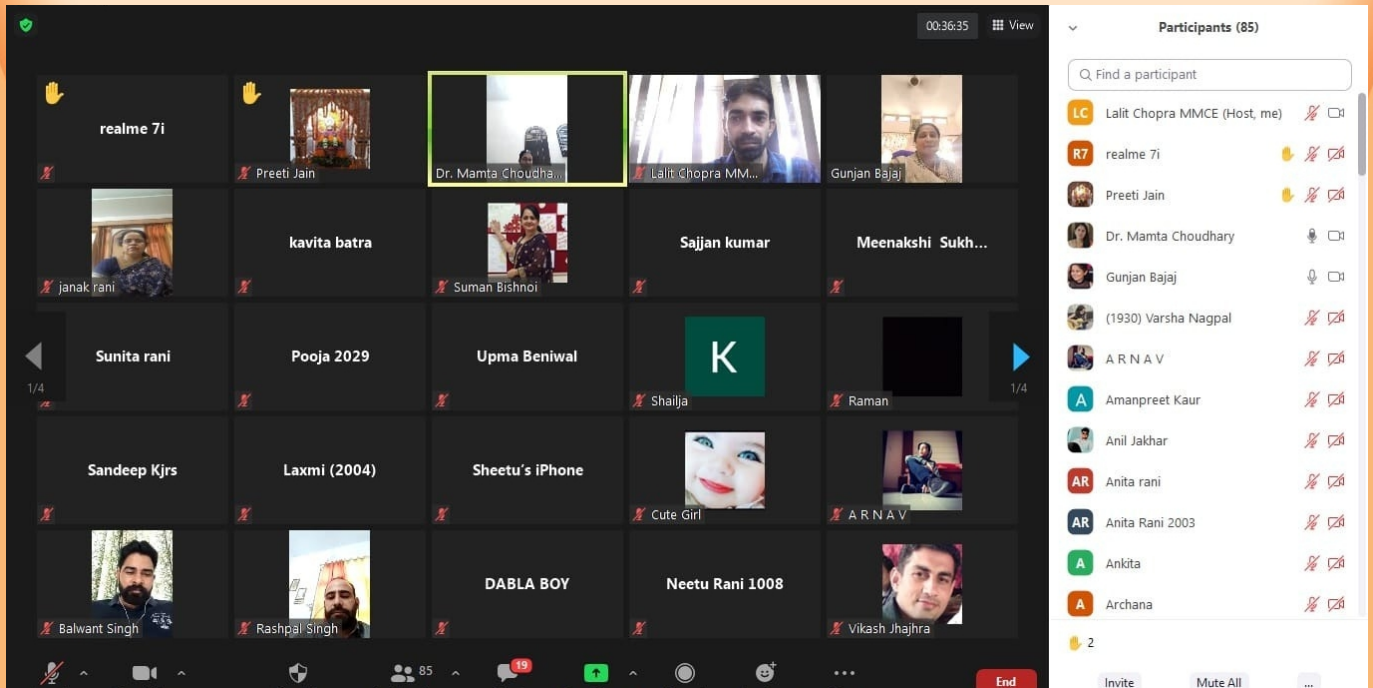

## Two day International Webinar



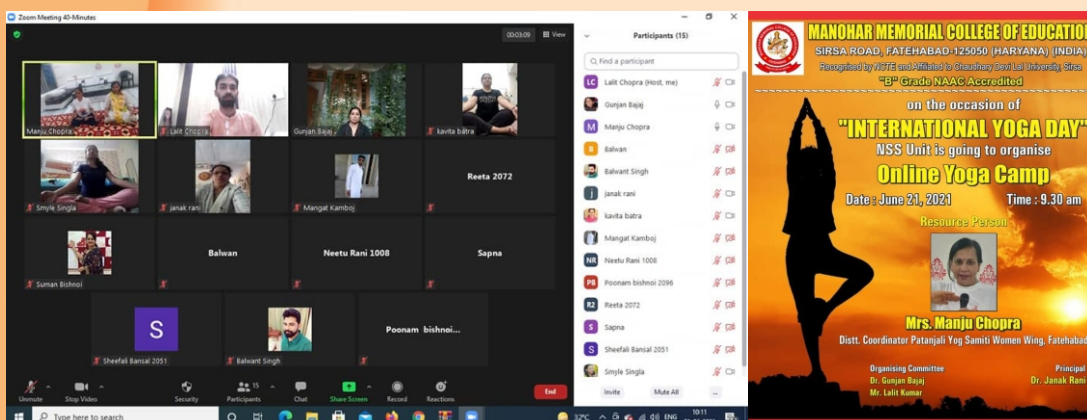

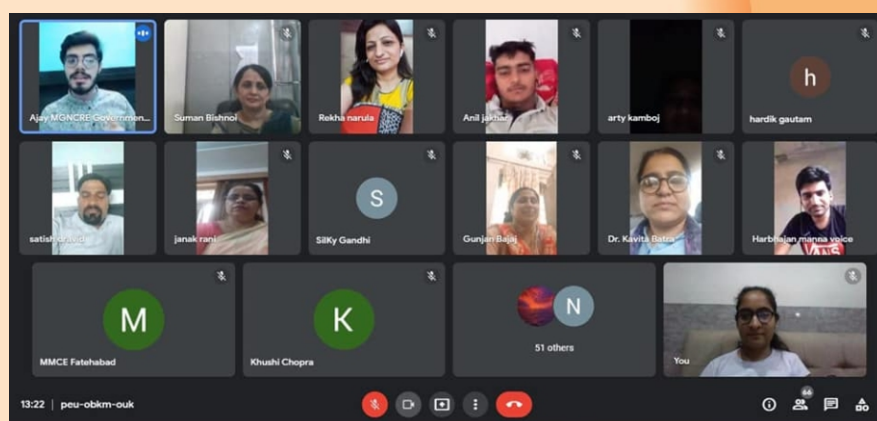
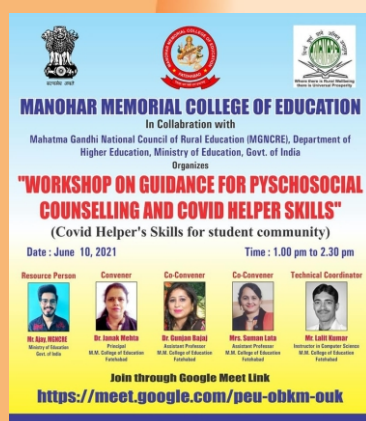


# Alumni Meet



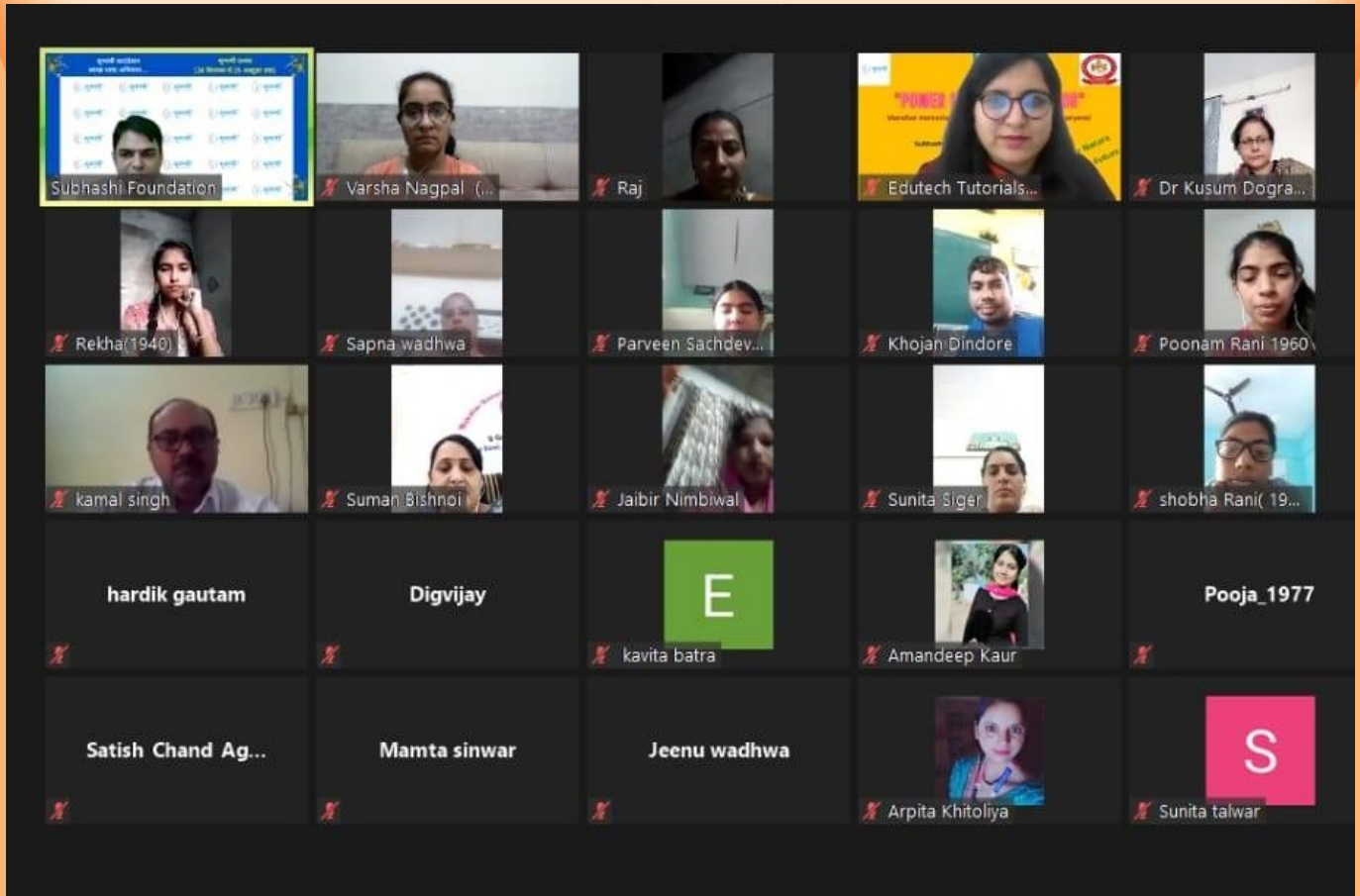

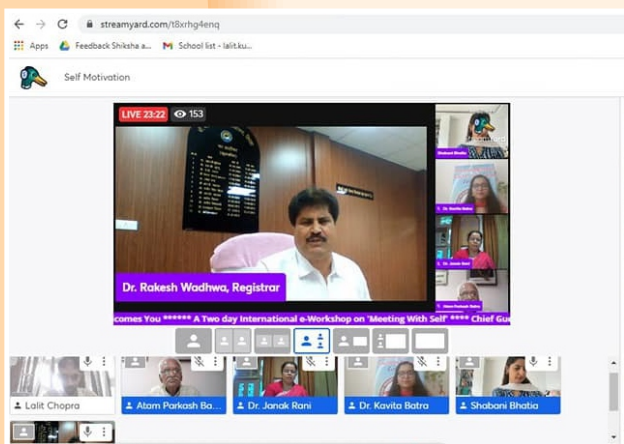


## COMPUTERISED LIBRARY
