
Lohri Celebrations



Two day International Webinar






Workshop on Psycho - Social Counselling & Covid Helper skills

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A Tribute to Manohar Batra

(22.09.1946 - 21.10.1967)

The Manohar Memorial Group of Institutions stands as a shining testimony to the fond remembrance of a promising young man whose life was snatched by the cruel hands of destiny at an unripe age of twenty two years. The very name 'Manohar' evokes and kindles feelings of reverence and gratitude,

Sh. Manohar Lal Batra was born on September 22, 1946 with a silver spoon in his mouth as the only son of a renowned millionaire philanthropist of the region Late Mehta Khem Raj Batra. He was a handsome, energetic and dynamic personality with social leanings. He was being groomed to inherit the family legacy and mantle of charity and social service when his earthly life was cut short in a tragic accident. He was a treasure house of goodwill, nobility and compassion. He was looked upon by everyone as a gem among his peers.

Motivated and activated by lofty ideals and prompted by the divine inspiration of Swami Geeta Nand Ji Maharaj of Tapowan, Haridwar, Mehta Khem Raj Batra decided to perpetuate the memory of his departed son. The foundation stone of this college was laid on May 17, 1970 by the then Chief Minister of Haryana Shri Bansi Lal.

The birth of a college at Fatehabad had laid the people of this educationally backward region under deepdebt of gratitude. But for this munificent gift this area would have been deprived of advantages and benefits of higher education. The public spirited dignitaries and illuminaries of the town greeted the founding of this college as a courageous adventure, worthy endeavour and sublime enterprise. It thus became a community project and soon dug its roots deep in the soil below and started spreading its ample branches in the lifegiving open, fresh and Invigorating air above. It has shaped and grown today as one of the most prestigious and front-ranking institutions of the state.

The Manohar Memorial Education Society, Fatehabad presently boasts of its Trinity - A chain of three Institutions. Manohar Memorial College of Education, Fatehabad came into existence in the year 2004-05 followed by Manohar Memorial Polytechnic in the year 2005. All the three Institutions have earned distinct repute in their own right.

BRIEF PROFILE OF THE INSTITUTION

Motivated by noble desire of equipping the educated youth of the region professionally with teaching & technical skills and activated by the societal needs of future, the Society established M.M. College of Education in the year 2004 to impart education for the B.Ed. Degree course thus adding yet another constitutent in the chain of institutions being run by this Society. D.Ed. Course was also added in the year 2007. B.A.B.Ed. Course has also been added recently in the year 2022. The college campus is located in the heart of the city adjacent to Model Town right on the National Highway (NH-9). The town of Fatehabad is the District



Headquarter known for its rich agricultural production and is inhabited by progressive landlord gentry and enterprising grain merchants. It is connected in either direction of the NH-9 by the District towns of Hisar (48KM) and Sirsa (42HM).

The college boasts of an elegant infrastructural edifice with a harmonious academic ambience for learning. The Society runs one other instituion besides M.M. College of Education viz. 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

(22-09-1946 to 21-10-1967)

The Manohar Memorial Group of Institutions stand as a shining testimony to the fond remembrance of a promising young man whose life was snatched by the cruel hands of destiny at an unripe age of twenty two years. The very name 'Manohar' evokes and kindles feelings of reverence analogous to those illumined and inspired by the 'Goddess Saraswati'.

Sh. Manohar Lal Batra was born with a silver spoon in his mouth as the only son to a renowned millionaire philanthropist of the region Late Mehta Khem Raj Batra on September 22, 1946. He was a handsome, energetic and dynamic personality with social leanings. He was being groomed to inherit the family legacy and mantle of charity and social service when his earthly life was cut short in a tragic accident. He was a treasure house of goodwill, nobility and compassion. He was looked upon by everyone as a gem among his peers.

Motivated and activated by lofty ideals and prompted by the divine inspiration of Swami Geeta Nand Ji Maharaj of Tapowan, Haridwar, Mehta Khem Raj Batra decided to perpetuate the memory of his departed son. The foundation stone of this college was laid on May 17, 1970 by the then Chief Minister of Haryana Shri Bansi Lal.

The birth of a college at Fatehabad had laid the people of this educationally backward region under deep debt of gratitude. But for this munificent gift this area would have been deprived of advantages and benefits of higher education. 
